Take the article "the," for example. We use "the" whether we're referring to "book" or "magazine": "the book" and "the magazine.". In Spanish, however, a book (libro) is considered masculine, and a magazine is feminine (revista). So in Spanish, we say, "el libro" (the book) and "la revista" (the magazine).
