The Zimbabwe African National Union was a militant organisation that fought against white minority rule in Rhodesia, formed as a split from the Zimbabwe African People's Union. ZANU split in 1975 into wings loyal to Robert Mugabe and Ndabaningi Sithole, later respectively called ZANU-PF and ZANU - Ndonga. These two sub-divisions ran separately at the 1980 general election, where ZANU-PF has been in power ever since, and ZANU - Ndonga a minor opposition party.
