A vaccination program should be in place where there is a significant risk of exposure to Hepatitis A or Tetanus (eg workers in regular contact with sewage). The Australian Immunisation Handbook recommends vaccinations for Hepatitis A and Tetanus (as dT or dTpa - ie with Diphtheria +/- Pertussis) for these workers.

## **Best practice guidance for reducing health risk for ...**

Controlling risks to sewage workers. Workers whose activities bring them into contact with untreated sewage and sewage are at risk of contracting a work-related infections including BBVs. Detailed guidance is available: Infection at work: Controlling the risks.

Vaccine management and logistics support. Logistics support is critical to immunization services to ensure the availability of appropriate equipment and an adequate supply of high-quality vaccines and immunization-related materials to all levels of the programme.

## **Vaccine management and logistics support**

Dispose of through a hazardous waste disposal company. Unused preservative-free inactivated vaccines (most commonly single-use vials and some pre-filled syringes) Non-infectious and non- hazardous Medical waste disposal service or reverse distributor – do not dispose of in regular trash; remove unused needle from syringe to manage with sharps. Used cotton balls, gauze, gloves and dried alcohol wipes Empty vials of inactivated vaccines Non-infectious and non- hazardous ...

## **Disposal of waste/outdated vaccine**

These workers should follow the guidelines provided in the CDC Interim Guidance for Managers and Workers Handling Untreated Wastewater from Suspected or Confirmed Individuals with Ebola in the U.S. to prevent exposure to Ebola when working with untreated wastewater.
