#### Water Softener Bypass Valve Operation

The bypass valve on a Culligan™ water softener (and probably most others) connects to the back of the main control valve assembly with two screws. If the valve is difficult to operate it may need lubrication. Inside are o-rings that permit the valve to operate without leaking.

#### Water Softener Bypass Valve Operation & Repair Guide

Isolate the Water Softener. Ensure that the water softener is adjusted separately from the water supply. This can be done by a specific valve called the bypass valve. It is found on the control at the back. Simply rotate the knob in a clockwise direction up to the point where the two knobs, on and off lock into each other unlike during normal operation.

The 3 valve bypass has 2 valves plumbed on either side of the system that are normally "open" and one valve in the middle that is normally closed. Turn both outer valves off by rotating "clockwise". #### **Water Softener Bypass**

Open the outlet valve of the softener, or if using optional bypass place to NORMAL OPERATION MODE(figure 3). Allow control to finish theRINSEcycle. It will then advance to the FILLposition. The brine tank will now automatically fill with the proper volume of water for the first regeneration.

### INSTALLATION, OPERATING AND SERVICE MANUAL

Softener manufacturers supply a bypass valve. Push the valve to the bypass position, then turn off power to the water softener. To locate the bypass valve, look for two pipes that are connected to the water softener. One can be traced to the inlet and the other would be softened water flowing to the rest of the house.

## How to Maintain Your Water Softening System: 15 Steps

Under control of the water softener timer and control head (or during a manual regeneration cycle initiated by the user), water flows from the building water supply through the control head or control valve, down the center tube of the water softener, up through the water softener drain.

Make sure they snap into place. Pull on the bypass valve, or installation adaptors, to make sure they are held securely in place. 3. MOVE THE UNIT INTO INSTALLATION POSITION a.Move the water softener into the desired location. Set it on a solid, level surface. IMPORTANT:Do not place shims directly under the salt storage tank to level the softener.

With the bypass valve in the bypass

position, open a cold water tap nearby and let it run a few minutes. Once free from air, close tap. Partly open bypass to allow water to slowly fill tank. Once water stops running into the tank, rotate the bypass valve into the full service position.
