Answer: The Bible does not say much about Moses' wife, Zipporah. We know that she was the daughter of a man called Jethro (or Reuel), who was a priest in the land of Midian (Exodus 3:1; cf. 2:18). The Bible does not explicitly say that Moses had more than one wife. However, Numbers 12:1 leads many to surmise another wife: "Miriam and Aaron began to talk against Moses because of his Cushite wife, for he had married a Cushite."

So then who was Moses Wife? We know that he married a girl named 'Zipporah' the daughter of Reuel/Jethro. However these people were the descendants of Abraham and Keturah Gen.25:2. They were Midianites living in North West Arabia, just South of the Eastern arm of the Red Sea, known to us as the gulf of Aquaba.

Earlier, in the Book of Exodus, Moses indeed meets his wife Zipporah in a land far outside Egypt (in that passage the land is referred to as Midian: by either name, a remote foreign place). So, what underlies this malice by Moses' siblings against his wife, their own sister-in-law?

Tzipporah, the wife of Moses, is referred to as a Cushite. Why is she described as a Cushite when she actually was a Midianite? The Cushites historically were a dark-skinned people. Interestingly, anyone who accepted this account held that Moses was already married to Tharbis, his Cushite wife, before Moses fled to Midian and later married Zipporah. The account presupposes a polygamist marriage with Zipporah being the second wife.

NJAB - Who was Moses' wife? A Midianite, a Cushite, or both?

Answer: Zipporah in the Bible was the wife of Moses and the daughter of Jethro, the priest of Midian. When Moses fled from Egypt to the land of Midian, he met Jethro's seven daughters, who were having some trouble getting enough water for their flocks (Exodus 2).
